### Use objects or pictures around the house to describe new vocabulary

- **Use objects or pictures around the house to describe new vocabulary** – For example, if you're reading a book about a prickly porcupine, you could plan to show a hairbrush with *prickly* bristles to help your child understand the meaning of the word.
- **Plan questions or comments that will help your child understand a word by relating it to her own experience** – For example, if you're introducing the word "drenched," plan to talk about the time you ran home together in the rain because you forgot to bring an umbrella.
- **Use notes** – You can write your ideas for making words sparkle on sticky notes and place them in the book as helpful reminders.

Of course, you may not always get to every learning opportunity you've planned in just one reading. It's important to take your time and "go with the flow" of your child's interests. If she's very interested in talking about a certain word or idea, take advantage of her interest and keep the conversation going as long as you can. Remember that your child learns best when she is most interested.

### Tell

<b>Name the category or define the word</b>	"A pedestrian is a person who gets from one place to another on foot."
<b>Use familiar Step 1 words</b>	"This woman is a pedestrian. She is walking on the sidewalk."
<b>Provide details</b>	"Most streets have sidewalks just for pedestrians and trucks."
<b>Talk about what the word is and what it is not</b>	"A pedestrian is someone who is walking on the sidewalk, not driving or riding a bike on the road."

### and Relate

<b>Relate the word to your child's experiences or knowledge</b>	"When we walked to the grocery store yesterday, did you see a pedestrian?"
<b>Talk about other situations in which the word could be used</b>	"Sometimes a bridge is built only for pedestrians. Can you think of a place where a pedestrian bridge would be helpful?"

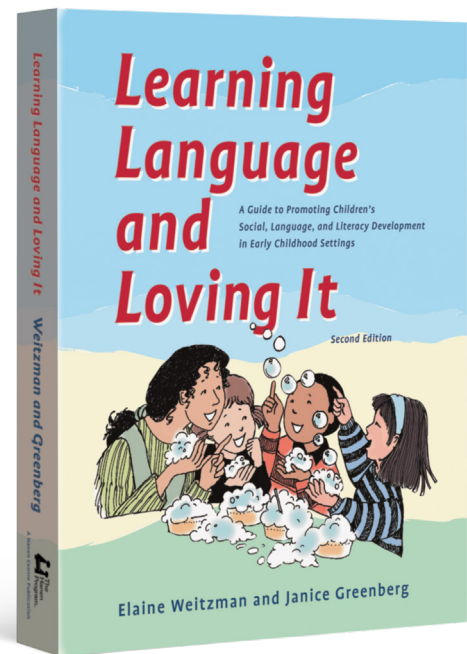
### Say it again

<b>Use the word before, during and after the book reading</b>	Before the reading tell your child what a pedestrian means. During the reading talk more about the word. After the reading use the word again. For example, talk about the crosswalk for pedestrians in the book.
<b>Read the book again</b>	Give your child the chance to read the book again. Make the word familiar with the word "pedestrian."
<b>Use the word again throughout the day</b>	When out for a walk, talk about the rules that apply to pedestrians.
